Wind Turbines Planning Inquiry Result

The Secretary of State, Eric Pickles, has announced that his decision regarding the wind turbine planning application for Hemphall has been delayed. He has not indicated when it will be made.



Village Hall / Playing Field Car park

We are pleased to report that the village hall committee together with the parish council has arranged for the resurfacing of the car park and driveway. This facility serves both the village hall and the playing field and under a longstanding agreement dating back to the time

that the parish council donated the land to the village hall, the costs have been shared between us and the village hall charity. We are grateful for all the hard work put into this project by the village hall team.

Play area

Despite regular maintenance, over the years the play equipment on the Bungay Road Playing Field is in need of attention. This is partly due to wear and tear caused by so many people enjoying the use of these facilities and partly due to its age. We are currently developing a strategy to raise funds to improve the equipment. Certain repair work is also urgently needed

and is underway. As a temporary measure, for health and safety reasons, we have fenced off certain of the equipment until repairs can take place. We ask for your patience during this time and we hope to bring the equipment back into full use as soon as possible.



Parking on pavements and at junctions

Again, parishioners have expressed concern about residents parking on the pavements and close to junctions. The village is blessed with many elderly people with and without walk aids and young families with push chairs, such parishioners find it difficult and dangerous to walk on the
