An Update from the Speedwatch Team



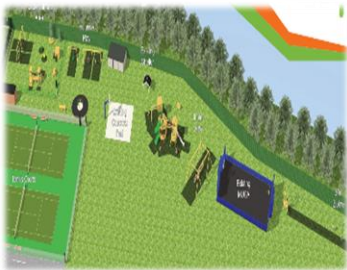
It is pleasing to report that the team has recruited more members. We have been active in the village but hope to be able to increase the number of
